GENERAL

Set high on a plateau which forms a natural boundary to the Zambezi National Park, Victoria Falls Safari Lodge enjoys uninterrupted views of unspoilt bushveld, spectacular African sunsets and an on-site waterhole. A complimentary shuttle service transports guests to the Victoria Falls (only 4km / 2.5mils away) and town centre on an hourly basis throughout the day.

- 4km / 2.5 miles from the Victoria Falls Rain Forest
- 3km / 2 miles from Victoria Falls Town Centre
- 24km / 15 miles from Victoria Falls Airport
- 170km / 106 miles from Hwange Game Reserve
- 5km / 3 miles from Zambian Border (Livingstone)
- 100km / 62 miles from Chobe National Park (Botswana)

All beds are extra length.

The 6 Lodge Waterhole Facing Suites all have king size beds. **NB.** These king size beds cannot be configured into twins.

All Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms and Lodge Standard Rooms have 2 three-quarter beds that can be converted to a king size bed.

In total, there are 5 sets of inter-leading rooms - 2 in Lodge Standard Rooms (double inter-leading into a twin) and 3 in Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms (any configuration).

In Lodge Standard Rooms – a maximum occupancy of 2 adults or 1 adult + 1 child (3-11 years). 2 of the Lodge Standard Rooms can accommodate an extra roller bed for a child.

In Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms – a maximum occupancy of 2 adults or 1 adult + 1 child (3-11 years). 3 of the Lodge Waterhole Facing Rooms can accommodate an extra roller bed for a child.

Lodge Waterhole Facing Suite – maximum occupancy of 2 adults + 1 child (3-11 years). The extra roller bed for the child is prepared in the lounge.

ROOM DESCRIPTION

All rooms have digital safes, phones, remote control air conditioning, hairdryers, ceiling fans, mosquito nets, an extensive range of customized toiletries, complimentary tea and coffee making facilities.

Buffalo Bar	An open plan bar with its own game-viewing platform overlooking the waterhole. Open from 10:30 – 23:00.
Victoria Falls Safari Lodge Pool Deck and Viewing Deck	A delicious snack menu and bar service is available from 10:30 to 18:00. Additionally, this location offers a wonderful view of the 'Vulture Culture Experience', which takes place in front of the Buffalo Bar viewing deck at 13:00 daily.

IN-HOUSE SAFARI ACTIVITIES
